2021 Membership Information & Rules

TYPES OF MEMBERSHIPS

HOUSEHOLD POOL MEMBERSHIP: \$395

For households with at least 2 members

Includes use of the pool all season, 5 guest passes, and participation in all Association-sponsored activities. Enjoy free Wi-Fi at the pool!

SINGLE/SENIOR POOL MEMBERSHIP: \$245

For households of 1 person OR 2 people if one is 65+ by June 30, 2021

Includes use of the pool all season, 5 guest passes, and participation in all Association-sponsored activities. Enjoy free Wi-Fi at the pool!

I SUPPORT WENDWOOD MEMBERSHIP: \$95

For households not interested in pool membership

Help us beautify the neighborhood with landscaping projects and participate in any Association-sponsored activity outside of the pool.

ADD-ONS, FEES, & PASSES

GUEST ADD-ONS: \$50 each

Add-ons allow Members to bring a different guest anytime they visit the pool. Great for bringing a friend, babysitter, neighbor, or more.

LOCAL GUESTS: \$5 per guest per day

Guests can be anyone living between a 1-mile and 50-mile radius of the pool. Neighbors living within a 1-mile radius of Wendwood do not qualify as Local Guests, but can be a guest add-on. All guests must be accompanied by a current pool member.

NON-LOCAL GUESTS: FREE

Guests who live beyond a 50-mile radius of the pool can be brought for free. Guests must be accompanied by a current pool Member.

GUEST PASSES: \$5 per pass OR \$50 for 12 passes

Guest passes can be purchased individually or in groups of 12. Passes must be submitted to the snack shack attendant or lifeguard on duty when arriving with a guest.

MEMBERSHIP CARDS & SIGN IN

MEMBERSHIP CARDS

Membership cards will be issued to all members of the pool and must be carried when visiting the pool.

SIGN-IN

When visiting the pool, each member is required to sign-in at the pool entrance. The member's name, membership number, number of people and type of guest, as well as the date and time must be noted.

Any guest passes **MUST** be submitted at this time.

SWIM TEAM

The Wendwood Wahoos is a competitive swim team in the Blue Division of the Greater Peninsula Swimming Association (GPSA). The team is open to children who are included in a Pool Membership. The annual swim team fee is separate from the pool membership.

POOL SEASON & HOURS

As of March 20, 2021, the official pool season and hours have not yet been determined. The intent is to open the pool by Memorial Day weekend, as long as state COVID-19 safety protocols will allow it. The Wendwood Association Board is monitoring the situation closely and will announce the pool season and hours at wendwoodpool.com at least three weeks before the season begins.

POOL PARTIES & RENTALS

POOL RENTAL

The pool will be available for rental between the hours of 7 p.m. and 11 p.m. 7 days a week. The pool will also be available for rental on Sunday from 9 a.m. until 12 p.m. The rental fee for members is \$45 per hour for up to 50 people PLUS a lifeguard fee of \$10.00 per lifeguard per hour. The rental fee for non-members is \$75 per hour for up to 50 people PLUS a lifeguard fee of \$10 per hour per lifeguard. All rentals must be reserved through Membership Chair Carol Minter (carol_minter@hotmail.com or 757-268-4899).

A Pool Rental Policy with the pool rental guidelines must be signed and a non-refundable \$25 must be paid at the time of the pool reservation. Visit wendwoodpool.com/parties to schedule a party and pay the deposit.

POOL PHONE

The pool phone (757-249-9000) is required by city code and is intended for *emergency use only*.

POOL RULES & REGULATIONS

- The Lifeguards are authorized to close the pool during the presence of hazardous environmental conditions, e.g., thunderstorms, due to equipment malfunction, and/or if the chemical balance or disinfectant levels are outside permissible levels.
- The pool will close on cold or rainy days if the forecast calls for these conditions to continue after 1 hour passes with no one swimming.
- The Lifeguards may clear the pool at any time or during a 10-minute break every hour. Those 18 years of age or older may continue swimming at the Lifeguard's discretion. Children under 18 **MUST** stay clear of the pool edge.
- Any problems with the grounds, building, pool equipment, or infractions of the rules should be reported to the Lifeguards.
